Pupils will explore the Christian belief in God as creator, the Genesis creation accounts, and scientific explanations. They will study God's call and covenant with Abraham, Moses, and the Old Testament narrative.	Pupils will explore the prophets' teachings about the Messiah, Jesus Christ. They will study Advent, the nativity, and the mystery of the incarnation.	Pupils will learn about Jesus' life, his revelation of the Kingdom of God, and his call to the disciples. They will study his parables, encounters, miracles, and teachings.	Pupils will study Lent, Holy Week, and the Paschal Triduum. They will learn about the journey from Lent to Resurrection and the Paschal transition from darkness to light, death to life.	Pupils will study the Resurrection, Ascension, and the Holy Spirit's arrival, focusing on the apostles and early Church. They will learn about the modern Catholic Church as the apostolic Church and its liturgy and structures.	Pupils will learn how Christians collaborate with others for the common good, respecting human dignity. They will also explore other beliefs and the Church's teaching on intercultural dialogue.
